MU Academic Programs

The Mizzou Center provides advising, educational opportunities and career services for undergraduate and graduate students in person and via video conferencing.

MU College of Engineering

Missouri Procurement Technical Assistance Center counsels businesses in the Kansas City area to help them procure federal, state and local government contracts.

MU College of Education

School of Information Science and Learning Technologies provides website usability testing for businesses, government agencies and others and taps faculty expertise to design training programs and information services.

Charter School Office provides oversight in the areas of academic achievement, federal and state compliance, governance and finance for public charter schools located within Missouri's Kansas City and St. Louis school districts.

MU College of Veterinary Medicine

Develops and extends research partnerships within the KC Animal Health Corridor, which runs from Columbia, Mo., to Manhattan, Kan.

MU Extension Food and Nutrition Program

Manages the program's nutrition education exhibits and coordinates the translation of materials, displays and school presentations into other languages.

MU Office of Research

Location

The Mizzou Center is located off I-70 and Adam's Dairy Parkway adjacent to the Missouri Innovation Park, Adam's Pointe Conference Center and Hotel, shopping areas, restaurants and a golf course. Easy access to the greater Kansas City area. Driving time to downtown Kansas City is 25 minutes, and the KCI Airport is 45 minutes away.



The Facility

- The Mizzou Center occupies the first floor of the Heartland Financial Building in Blue Springs, Missouri.
- It contains 10,765 square feet consisting of 17 private offices, five semi-private offices, work room, a kitchen and storage. The Mizzou Center also has a 16-person conference room, one that holds 30 people and access to a 14-person executive conference room on the second floor.
- The center is connected to the MU technology infrastructure through a fiber optic connection of 10 Mb.

Business Space

- Private offices are available in the center's corporate suite.
- Offices range in size from 162 to 263 square feet and are competitively priced.
- Amenities include utilities; free parking; central reception and package delivery services; access to conference rooms, the kitchen, work room, technology (25-laptop computer lab, interactive television, polycom unit and projectors); and use of existing furniture.
- Available business services include private phone, broadband access and copy service.
- Space can be used for flexible time periods.
